

What is a Long Range Vision Plan?

A Long Range Vision Plan is a process of developing a perspective on how your goals can be supported in strategic facility planning, design, and execution. This process helps with short to long term planning and project identification, understanding the role the built environment plays in your strategic goals, a clear path forward within a living document which responds to current and future understanding of needs, and anticipated operational outcomes.

Vision Planning helps churches see and understand their ministry area context and demographics. Insight into community trends to test future facilities and aid in decision making in facility and campus development and redevelopment.

What are our guiding principals for this Vision Plan?

- SPIRITUALITY | Enhance an already flourishing parish community by building on a strong foundation of parish values and evangelism, that extends and connects both parish and school, creating a support system to spread God's word through ministry and outreach.
- PARISH COMMUNITY | Promote a vibrant multi-generational and diverse parish community, by creating a holistic campus approach for outreach, community building and gathering.
- SCHOOL | Support the demand for Catholic education and extra curriculars within the community through a focus on flexibility of spaces, accessibility, security, and reinforcing a strong connection to the parish community.
